



## KENNEL DISINFECTING PROTOCOL

Always remove animals, food and water dishes, bedding and toys from the area before implementing the cleaning protocol.

### KENNEL DISINFECTING PROTOCOL

Frequency: Daily

1. Remove all solid waste.
2. Rinse floor towards drain to remove urine and heavy soil.
3. Flush drain.
4. Using a dedicated foam gun, pour full strength **Animal Facility Disinfectant** into foam gun reservoir tank. Or, dilute the solution in a pump-up sprayer.
5. Start at the top of the cage or run and work down and out covering the entire surface.
6. Allow the solution to stand for a minimum of 10 minutes to ensure complete effectiveness.
7. Rinse or squeegee solution towards the drain.
8. Remove puddles before reintroducing animals to the area.
9. Rinse any dishes, toys, etc. that may have come in contact with the cleaning solution.

#### SAFETY:

1. Always wear protective gloves when using cleaning chemicals.
2. Always wear protective goggles when applying cleaning solutions above eye level.
3. Use Wet Floor Safety Signs to avoid dangerous slip and falls.
4. Wash hands thoroughly.
