



THE CATTERY PROTOCOL

Add these steps to the hard surface protocol when cleaning and disinfecting in the cattery.



1. Fill a specially labeled spray bottle using a mixture of 1 to 1.25 ounces of **Animal Facility Disinfectant** per gallon of water.



2. Set the spray bottle nozzle to the course or stream setting to minimize migration of the chemical spray.



3. Remove cats, dishes, toys and bedding. Discard used litter. Clean litter box and refresh litter.



4. Apply the solution by holding the spray bottle 6 to 8 inches above the surface. Spray the surface, including cage doors, handle and all other touch points.



5. Agitate the surface using a disposable wiping towel. Use a brush with synthetic handle and bristles to remove heavy soil and/or to clean cage wire and other hard to reach areas.

6. Allow solution to stand for at least 10 minutes.

7. Wipe up any excess moisture.

8. It is important to clean and disinfect wheels on cages, carts and trash receptacles that move from area to area.

9. Allow the surface to dry thoroughly before reintroducing animals back to the area.

SAFETY:

1. Always wear protective gloves when using cleaning chemicals.
2. Always wear protective goggles when applying cleaning solutions above eye level.
3. Use Wet Floor Safety Signs to avoid dangerous slip and falls.
4. Wash hands thoroughly.
