For the Veterinary Hospital

A Veterinary Hospital or Clinic provides a wide range of veterinary services from simple check-ups and dental care to surgical procedures. A Veterinary Hospital may also offer a variety of other services including daycare, overnight boarding, grooming and retail supplies. Veterinary Hospitals are constructed with a wide range of surface materials. A thorough inspection of the facility and surfaces materials should be conducted before developing and implementing the cleaning/disinfecting program.





Public Areas & Restrooms

Attention to the public areas of an animal care facility including the lobby, waiting room, retail area and restrooms is the "First Line of Defense" in minimizing cross-contamination. A wide range of bacteria and viruses can be transported into the facility and transferred via touchpoints. Use Animal Facility Disinfectant to mop floors and to wipe down touchpoints including door knobs & handles, counter tops, tables, retail shelves and other hard nonporous surfaces.

Feline Care & Boarding (Cattery)

Cats (big & small) are very sensitive to strong chemicals, such as bleach, as well as chemical mists and vapors.

For Spray Applications: Mix a solution of **Animal Facility Disinfectant** in a properly labeled spray bottle and set the spray nozzle to the "Coarse" setting.

For Wet Wiping Applications: Mix 1-ounce of Animal Facility

Disinfectant with 32-ounces of water and pour the solution over the dry towel roll in the Refillable Wiping System Canister.

Kennel Area (The 80/20 Rule)

There are two types of kennels, the Well Kennel (boarding) and the Shelter Kennel. In a Well Kennel, we recommend cleaning 80% of the time with our Kennel & Turf Care Enzymatic Cleaner and 20% of the time with our Animal Facility Disinfectant. We recommend reversing the process when cleaning a Shelter Kennel.



The active ingredients in **Kennel & Turf Care** will breakdown odor and disease causing organic matter to help control odors that can develop on floors and in floor drains.

Use **Kennel & Turf Care** to clean and deodorize synthetic pet turf, exterior walkways, outside kennels and landscape substrate.




Our V97 ProFoam 2 will allow the user to dilute, apply and rinse the solution, reducing both labor and chemical costs.




Animal Facility Disinfectant can be applied at two dilution ratios, 1.25 ounces per gallon of water for general cleaning/disinfection applications or 4 ounces per gallon of water when there is an outbreak of Canine Parvovirus. The diluted solution should be allowed to stand for 10-minutes before rinsing the surface. Always remove puddles an heavy moisture before returning animals to the area.

Animal Facility Disinfectant can be used to clean and disinfect all surfaces that do not come into direct contact with the animal during surgery or examination, such as surgical instruments.

To help reduce overspray, excessive moisture and to speed up the cleaning process we recommend using our **Refillable Wiping System** and a Bucketless Mop System with Microfiber Flat Mops. To help minimize cross-contamination, we recommend using a green mop for general disinfecting and a red mop for isolation and other sensitive areas.
